




How to make your own woolen Bertrand!

How to make your own woolen Bertrand!

- ① What you'll need:
 - Tellow, black and white wool
 - ் Small scissors
 - ② 2 pompom makers (we used Clover 3.5 and 4.5cm diameter) or you can use DIY cardboard circles instead
 - ் Glue
 - Black pipe cleaners
- 2 Fill your pompom maker (or cardboard circles) by wrapping 'round yellow and black wool in stripes, as shown. 4-5 times should make a nice full pompom.
- 3 Once complete, cut through your pompom and tie tightly with a length of black or yellow wool.
- 4 Trim your pompom into a neat oval-shape to make Bertrand's body!
- (5) Make another, smaller pompom with yellow wool for Bertrand's head. Cut through and tie the pompom as above.
- 6 Trim into a neat circle and use the binding length to tie the head to the body. Or you can glue the two pieces together.
- ① Glue two black wool knots for the eyes and a short length of black wool for the mouth. Glue on two short pieces of black pipe cleaner for his antennae. Make two sets of loops with white wool and glue into place for the wings.
- 8 ... and there's your very own woolen Bertrand!
